READINGS FOR FAITH SHARING

June 3, 2012

Mass Page 210 in Missalette

- Reading I Deuteronomy 4:32-34, 39-40**
The Lord is God in the heavens above and on earth below and there is no other.
- Psalm 33** "Blessed the people the Lord has chosen to be his own."
- Reading II Romans 8:14-17**
You received a Spirit of adoption, through whom we cry, "Abba, Father!"
- Gospel: Matthew 28:16-20**
Baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Each year the scriptures chosen for Trinity Sunday begin with God's revelation to Israel. In today's first reading, Moses urges the people to be filled with wonder at God's love in reaching out to make them God's chosen people. But Paul declares that in Christ, God has drawn even closer to us, adopting us as children, so that we can address God as intimately as Jesus did, crying "Abba, Father." In the Gospel, Jesus commissions his disciples--and us--to share with everyone the Good News of God's personal love for them, a work and witness we will not have to do alone, because Jesus promises to be with us always.
