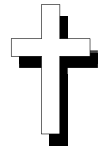

Mass Page 218 in Missalette

- Reading I** **Isaiah 49:1-6**
I will make you a light to the nations.
- Psalm 139** "I will praise you for I am wonderfully made."
- Reading II** **Acts 13:22-26**
John heralded his coming by proclaiming a baptism of repentance.
- Gospel:** **Luke 1:57-66, 80**
John is his name.

In today's first reading, John the Baptist, like Isaiah, was called by God from before his birth. Isaiah's words seem to describe John's mission of proclaiming the coming of God's salvation in Jesus to Israel and to the ends of the earth. Through baptism, God has called us to prepare the way for Jesus in our world. Though John the Baptist's father Zechariah, doubted, God's promise was fulfilled in John's birth. The name John means "God has been gracious." In the Jesus whom John proclaimed, God's plan will be graciously fulfilled for us also: the salvation of our souls.

There is a special bell sequence, which St. Landry uses, to mark the traditional time of these prayers, namely at 6am, 12pm, and 6pm. We, as a community, recently began to use the cards for prayer at 12pm before the 12:05pm Mass. Daily Mass is a great way to cement our devotion to God, so I hope all of you come as often as you can, and if possible come at noon for the preparatory prayer, recognizing in a temporal way that Our Blessed Mother, as a model of discipleship, leads us to her Son present in the Eucharist.
